If you do not hold an Australian passport, please let us know so that we may advise you of any additional requirements.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Tips (Gratuities) Tips are not included in the tour price for services of the driver throughout the tour. The recommended tip for the driver is AUD3 per person, per day which will be collected whilst on the tour.

Luggage You will be responsible for all your personal belongings whilst on the tour. With regards to luggage, you will need to carry your own luggage from the coach to the hotel room and back to the coach. The driver will assist with the loading and unloading of luggage from the coach. **Please note: luggage limit is 23kg per person.**
